WELCOME BACK TO BHAJANS AT SOAR VALLEY COLLEGE, GUIDELINES FOR OUR SAFETY

We are really pleased to be able to invite you all back to Soar Valley College for live bhajans from Sunday 6th March 2022.

We have updated our guidelines since the last time we returned to Soar Valley College, and the biggest change is that we will no longer be registering devotees who attend bhajans. However, we are still maintaining a lot of the other guidelines and processes to allow us to continue to resume bhajans as safely as possible for everyone. So please pay careful attention to the below points and remind yourself of our guidelines.

Our guidelines are as follows:

1. Please follow the latest NHS and Government guidelines about symptoms of COVID-19, when to self-isolate and if you need to quarantine when you arrive in England from abroad.

IF IN DOUBT, PLEASE DO NOT COME TO THE CENTRE TO HELP PROTECT OTHERS

2. You are asked to enter Soar Valley College from the dining hall entrance (see below) and not the main entrance



3. We recommend that everyone attending the centre wears a mask and maintains social distancing rules. Please also do not hug or shake hands with others

4. We also ask that you use the hand sanitisers which will be provided

5. Please note you will not be allowed into the main hall until all the set-up is complete

6. Men will be asked to remove their shoes in the dining hall and enter the main bhajan hall through the doors in the dining hall

7. Ladies will be asked to remove their shoes in the normal place and enter the main bhajan hall from the back as normal

8. Everyone will be seated on chairs and no-one (apart from the singers and instrumentalists) will be seated on the floor. Please do not move the chairs as we need to maintain the distance between the chairs. Please also remain in the same seat.

9. Soar Valley College has assigned specific toilets for our centre members to use. These are to the right of the dining hall. Our volunteers will show you which ones to use, please refrain from using any other toilets

10. Please do not come to the front and bow down at the altar after bhajans

11. We are trying to minimise the people who touch the centre set-up materials. So please do not try to help with the set-up or putting away of the altar and chairs at the end

12. Please do not bring flowers or any other items for the altar in order to minimise risk

We are dependent on everyone following these guidelines and listening to our volunteers so that we can conduct bhajans as safely as we can.
